Frequently Asked Questions

What is the Hamlin Education Center PACH Program? Since 2012, the Hamlin PACH Program provides complimentary meals and snacks to students who may need additional food resources. The program will operate throughout the 2017-2018 school year. Registration will be accepted anytime during the school year. Please contact your child's school counselor for more information on how to register.

How does the Hamlin PACH Program work? Children will receive the bagged food pack, in their backpack, before he/she leaves on the last school day of each week.

Who is eligible? Any child enrolled at the Hamlin Education Center in grades Pre-K through grade 12.

How do I register my child? Fill out a consent form or contact your child's school counselor for more information. The consent form can also be found on our website. When you complete the consent form, please return it to your child's school counselor. A parent/guardian is required to sign the consent form to be enrolled in the Hamlin PACH Program.

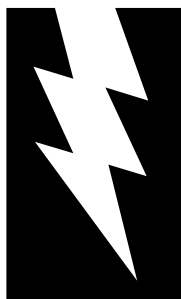
Can I register more than one child for the Hamlin PACH Program? Yes. If you have more than one child attending the Hamlin Education Center, you only need to submit one consent form. Please make sure to list all of your children on that form.

How will I know if my child is enrolled? Upon processing your form, if the Hamlin PACH Program has sufficient funds, your child/ren will begin to receive a supply of kid-friendly foods once a week. If there is not sufficient funds, you will be notified and your child will be placed on the waiting list.

Is this program associated with the Federal Free/Reduced Lunch Program? No, the Hamlin PACH Program operates solely through volunteers and donations from Hamlin area businesses and individuals.

How do I contribute or volunteer with the Hamlin PACH Program? Donations can be dropped off at any Reliabank location or by contacting Gail Krause.

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The Hamlin Education PACH Program provides complimentary snacks and meals to students who may need additional food resources over the weekends during the school year. During the 2017-2018 school year, students will receive one packed meal bag before he/she leaves on the last school day of the week.

Any child in grades Pre-K through Grade 12, enrolled at the Hamlin Education Center may participate in the Hamlin PACH Program. There are no eligibility requirements.

To register, simply complete the consent form below and turn it into your child's school counselor. Consent Forms will be accepted anytime during the school year and children will be served on a first come-first served basis.

If you have more than one child in school, please submit one form, listing ALL of your children enrolled at Hamlin in the spaces below. This information will be kept confidential.

Once your Consent Form is received, your child's name will be added to the list of students eligible for the Hamlin PACH Program. If the Hamlin PACH Program has sufficient funds, your child/ren will begin to receive a supply of kid-friendly foods once a week. If there is not sufficient funds, you will be notified and your child will be placed on the waiting list. It is best to communicate with your child that he/she will be receiving these packs and that they are to be brought home weekly.

Please consider letting this program help you and your family.
